COOPERATION

Join in to solve the problem.

Children will view you as an ally

SECURITY

Children who feel secure are more likely to share feelings about problems.

We are never upset for the reasons we think - when we feel secure, we can explore the real upset hiding behind our hostility and anger




intentions and actions

Child becomes conscious of their actions and their ability to choose a different course. You can help the child feel safe even as you help them realize the hurt their actions caused. They will be more ready to learn another way if they feel safe and loved.

OWN WILL

Acknowledge child does not need to obey you to be loved by you. You allow the child to discover their own true selves, instead of steering them to becoming people who seek outward approval



ACCEPTANCE

You plant the seeds of acceptance so the child can embrace diversity. People can look, think and act differently than you, and you can still accept them for who they are
